

What's in Broxbourne ?

- The 2012 Olympics White Water Canoe centre is located in Waltham Cross.
- The Laura Trott (Kenny) Leisure Centre is in Cheshunt along with a couple or so Gold post boxes celebrating one of our famous residents.
- The Cliff Richard retirement home named after another famous ex resident
- Ok now we are struggling but on the horizon there are some exciting developments being proposed.



- A space to breathe... a place to grow
 - So what is in the pipeline
 - Broxywood (ok that was Boris called it I suspect we wont be) A new 92 acre Film Studio at Junction 25 of the M25 (the A10) creating up to 4,500 jobs
 - A Mega Data centre of 65,000 sq m and adjoining Business Centre with 34,600 sq mt of office and business space about 500 yards north of Broxywood !
 - A new leisure and retail town centre providing much needed facilities unavailable elsewhere in the Borough known as Brookfield Riverside, with an associated Garden Village extension.
 - A new footpath and cycle route along the whole length of the New River as it passes through the Borough
 - Residential developments to provide 7,700 new homes by 2033.

- A 92 acre site
- Acquired by a US conglomerate
- Pre app discussions already in train with the Council planning team
 - Looking to invest £700 million into the development
 - Creation of 4,500 jobs
 - S106 spinoffs to be negotiated

Theobalds Business Park

- A major data centre of up to 65,000 m2
- Up to 34,600 m2 of B1 B2 and B8 development of which 14,000 sq m will be on land to be owned by the Council
- A new hi –tech Business and Innovation Centre of 3,200 sq m

Theobalds Business Park

S 106 negotiations provided a 5.7 acre site with outline planning permission for the business space. Council now has full planning permission to build a new Business and Innovation Centre of 3,200 sqm

- 25,000 m2 retail space
- A new Civic hub
- 250 residential units
- Two town squares

Brookfield Garden Village

- 330 acre site incorporating ancient woodland and historic groundworks all to be preserved
- 1,250 New homes
- A new 3 FE Primary School
- New footpath, cycle and roads infrastructure in tandem with Brookfield Riverside
- Bio diversity net gain
- New open spaces
- A community vineyard
- New allotments
- Relocation of a Travellers facility
- Relocation of Council depots and a new HWRC facility
- A new Blue Light Hub for Police, Fire and Ambulance





- First stage completed July this year


