	6.3	ACES Council Meeting 20/01/2024 DB provided an overview of the meeting, confirming that the Diploma course delivered jointly with CIPFA was proving popular and generating substantial income. There was a need to agree uses for the income which must be consistent with the charitable activities of the organisation. Nationally FACES continues to grow but there was a desire maintain the expansion and engagement, with branches encouraged to promote the initiative locally.	Noted

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7. Discussion Forum	7.1 KP raised the prospect of financial support for younger members to secure the CIPFA Asset Management qualification. AM to speak with David Bently.	AM
	7.2 SB sought recommendations for agents to assist the sale of an tenanted industrial estate, unsure of investor demand in Keith, Moray.	All
	7.3 DB raised the Single Scottish Estate programme which sought to reduce the public sector building footprint. MA confirmed there is no current target, but advised there had been a 470K sq m reduction in floorspace as a consequence of the previous target of 25% in Scottish Government organisations. Cost recovery is the basis of charging in sharing arrangements.	Noted
	7.4 The issue of staff resourcing was raised with various representatives confirming difficulty in recruitment, Discussion ensued including scope for sharing of staff resources, how to encourage youngsters. Sara advised that the skills gap was a national issues and advised of the "Love local Government" campaign to engage with the property sector.	Noted
	7.5 A brief discussion on recruitment difficulties highlighted the need to capture the interest of young people at an early opportunity, with engagement in schools essential. Scope for organisations to share staff offering scope to broaden experience as well as addressing peaks of workload pressures was a potential solution. SC advised the skills gap had been noted by the National Executive and advised that a national advertising campaign "Love Local Government" sought to address the issue. The Department of Education also sought to attract youngsters to the property profession highlighting the broad range of type and scale of projects that LA's deliver. MA highlighted the RICS interactive tool for schools which illustrated that both creative and numerative skill sets were appropriate for the diverse roles available in the property sector.	Noted
